BEFORE SCHOOL

Computer Animation

Offered by Miss Sanders

Using 3D's Max Software, students will create 3D objects on the computer including animation! Students will incorporate cameras and lighting into their projects.

Western Civilization II

AFTER SCHOOL

College Prep Math 1402-Algebra For College Students

This course is intended for those students who feel the need for an intensive review in the fundamentals of algebra. Topics to be covered include elementary algebraic operations, signed numbers, exponents and polynomials, simple equations, special products and factors, algebraic fractions and quadratic equations. Credit recovery is an option.
