## Rend Lake College

Rend Lake College is offering summer school make-up classes in the areas of English, math, science, history, government and consumer economics. BCHS requires 30 credits to graduate. If a student fails *more* than 2 one-credit classes, he/she will not be on target for graduation.

### Session 1

June 8<sup>th</sup> – June 26<sup>th</sup>

Morning: 8:00-12:00 = 1 class - .5 credit

Afternoon: 12:30-4:30 = 1 class - .5 credit

### Session 2

June 29<sup>th</sup> – July 17<sup>th</sup>

Morning: 8:00-12:00 = 1 class - .5 credit

Afternoon: 12:30-4:30 = 1 class - .5 credit

Classes meet on weekdays only. Students will register the first day at Rend Lake College Technology building in the lobby.

Summer school is provided free of charge to the parent.

If enough students register, BCHS will provide a bus. Students must pay a \$5.00 fee, which will cover three weeks of transportation to and from school. Students should be at BCHS on College Street by the faculty parking lot no later than 7:30 a.m. for the morning session and 12:00 noon for the afternoon session. RLC enforces a strict attendance policy. Students who miss more than 2 days of class will receive an automatic F. The grade will be sent to the high school and entered in their transcripts.
